^{*}The "Team Managers' Meeting" will take place on Thursday, June 28th, 2024 online and is mandatory for all team managers! The exact time will be published with the entry results at the latest.

General Regulations

- The regatta takes place on the regatta course Vienna Neue Donau/Steinspornbrücke according to the regulations of the RoR of the FISA supplemented by the RWB of the ÖRV. In addition, the following special provisions supplement or replace the set of rules.
- The race distance is 350 meters. There will be a flying start.
- Admission criteria:
 Under 30 years of age and student
- Rowers must be swimming competent. The participating clubs or universities bear full responsibility for the adequate state of health and training of the active participants.
- Coxswains do not have to fulfil the admission criteria. They must be at least 16 years old and eligible for coxing. Coxswains won't be weighed.
- University teams must be from the same university.
- Two university teams can also entry themself as a combination crew and need to be register as combination crew university A & university B.
- Coxswains must be swimming competent.
- Clothing within the team must be uniform.
- The boats are provided by the regatta management.
- Mixed category: teams must consist of 4 male and 4 female students.









Progression System

- All races will take place in Head-to-Head.
- Every University team will have at least 3 races before the Knock-Out-System starts.
- The progression mode is based on the number of entries per race. An example is given in the Annex. The final progression mode will be sent out with the entries.

Entries

- Entries are to be made exclusively to <u>university.rowing.vienna@gmail.com</u>
- The entries must contain the names and birth dates of the athletes, the university, and a team manager (incl. phone number).
- Entry Deadline: Friday, 14th June 2024 at 18:00 hrs.
- Late entries will be accepted until Wednesday, 26th June 2024 at 18:00 hrs.
- By registering, the registering club or university confirms that the participants have been informed that participation in the races may only be completed with appropriate clothing and equipment and in sufficient physical condition.
- The registering club confirms that the registered members agree to the
 processing of their personal data by the organizer and the ÖRV for the purpose
 of informing the public about participation and results within the framework of
 the data protection regulations; this agreement also applies to the publication of
 photos and film recordings.
- With the entry a team manager incl. phone number must be announced to <u>university.rowing.vienna@gmail.com</u>. The team manager agrees to receive information about the regatta via Whatsapp group.
- A deposit of € 160,00 per mixed-eight is required for the registration. In case of participation in the regatta it will be refunded.









Miscellaneous

- The storage of the boats and the parking of the boat transport trolleys are exclusively at your own risk. The organizer does not assume any liability.
- The winning teams will receive prizes.
- For the access to the regatta area with boat trailers and/or crew buses an entry permit is available against a deposit of 20,- euros.
- The COVID preventive measures are based on the legal requirements valid for the regatta weekend and will be strictly observed.
- Liability: The organizer is liable according to the provisions of Austrian statutory law. The insurance of material and persons is a matter of the participants. The organizer does not assume any liability for damages of any kind.
- **Approved** by the Technical Commission of the ÖRV on 29th April 2024 regarding conformity to the rules and regulations of the ÖRV and any deviations therefrom. The organizing club is liable for the compliance with all (also official) regulations.
